means is that we need to keep God

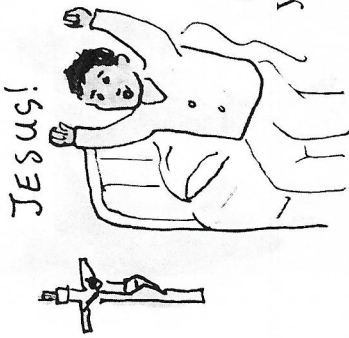
first in our lives. The two great

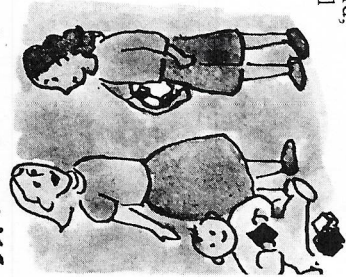

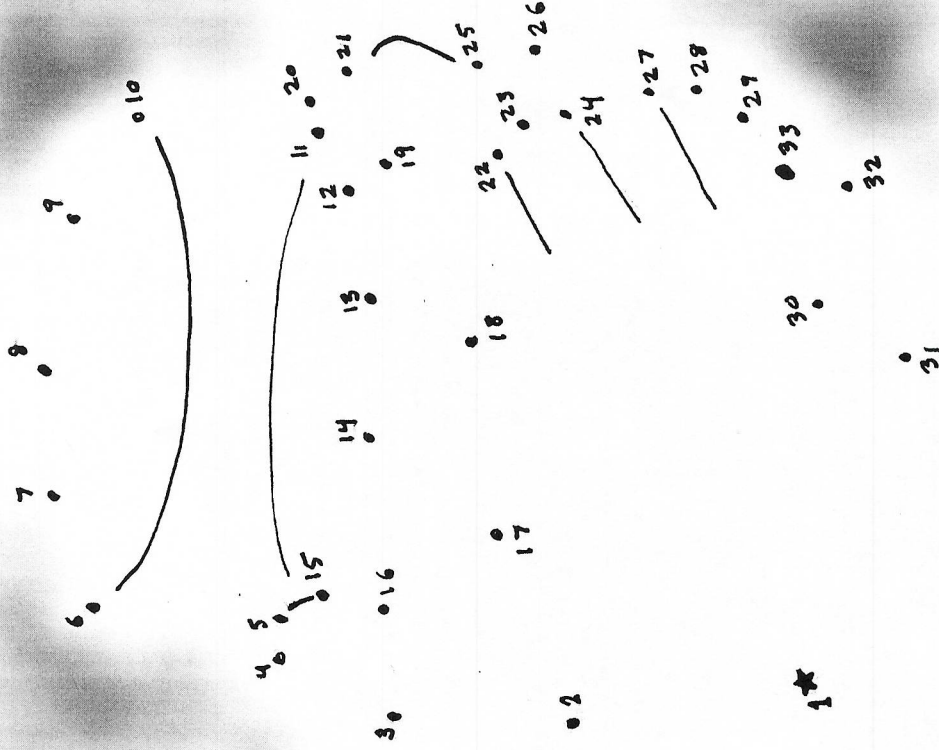
