Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick: Urgent calls will be attended to as soon as possible.

RCIA: The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is a process to bring non-Catholics into our faith. Additionally, it is also for previously baptized Catholics seeking to complete their sacraments of initiation.
