



HELPING HANDS FOOD PANTRY The Helping Hands Food Pantry has launched their 2023/24 Backpack Program for the Wyalusing Schools. This program is now its eighth year and provides healthy nutritional food items for students every weekend throughout the school year. For only \$25, you can sponsor a local child to have food for the entire year. Helping Hands is not government-sponsored and only receives donations from our generous community. During the school year, they provide weekend food for 285 families. They also provide over 90 weekend summer food bags to families who wish to participate. In addition, Helping Hands Food Pantry provides weekly food to anyone in need. Ninety families are currently shopping for food every week. They also provide delivery service to the elderly at the Park Place and deliveries are made to the elderly in Laceyville and in New Albany.
