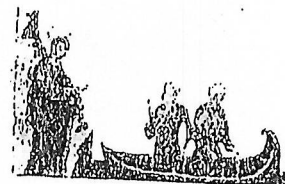

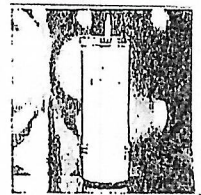

Sacrament of Baptism: Please call the Parish Office to make arrangements for your child's Baptism.

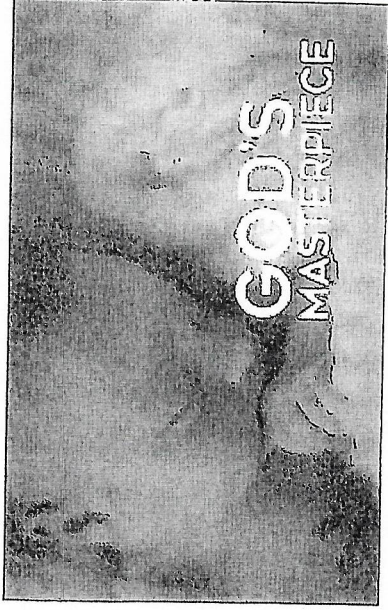
Sacrament of Marriage : Couples contemplating marriage should notify the Parish Office at least 6-9 months before your date to allow for necessary preparations.
