# **GRANT ANNOUNCEMENT**

The Ministry of Mercy Committee is happy to announce they have received a Parish Social Justice Grant from the Diocese of Scranton, and this is due to the generosity of donors to the Annual Appeal. Ministry of Mercy had designated \$2,000 in the grant application for Helping Hands Food Pantry. Currently, the Food Pantry is distributing 240 food bags every weekend throughout the school year in the backpack program. In addition to the backpack program, they also serve 80 families ever week by distributing bags of prepacked groceries, including eggs, milk, meat, canned goods, bread and other staples. Helping Hands is not government funded and continues to serve the Wyalusing Area only by the generosity of our community.
