## ST. BLAISE BLESSING OF THE THROAT

On this feast day, Catholics traditionally receive a blessing of the throat. This blessing is administered by a priest, deacon or a lay minister who follow the rites and prayers designated for a layperson. During this blessing, the minister takes two candles that were blessed on the feast of the Presentation and makes a cross in front of the throat, saying "Through the intercession of Saint Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from every disease of the throat and from every other illness." A priest or deacon will then make the sign of the cross. On Wed., Feb. 5<sup>th</sup>, the blessing of throats will take place at the 12:00 Noon Mass at St. Mary's and Tues., Feb. 4<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 PM SS Peter and Paul.
